

Installing and Using Double Driver

It backs up all your computer's drivers so when you reformat your hard drive, you can use it to restore your needed drivers without having to chase them down on the internet to get your computer working again.

Obtain the program (and then unzip it) from:

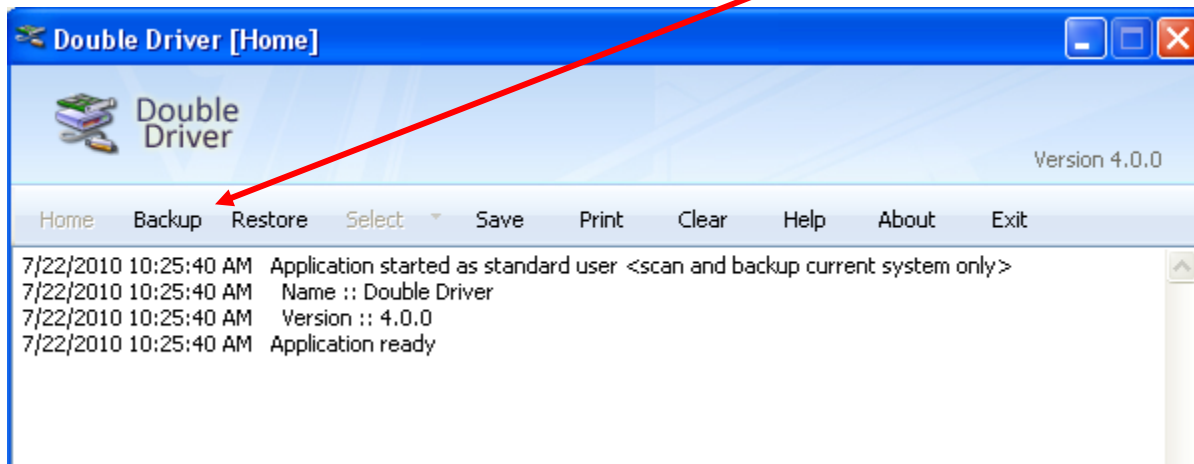

1. Copy the files to a single folder on your hard drive. They are:

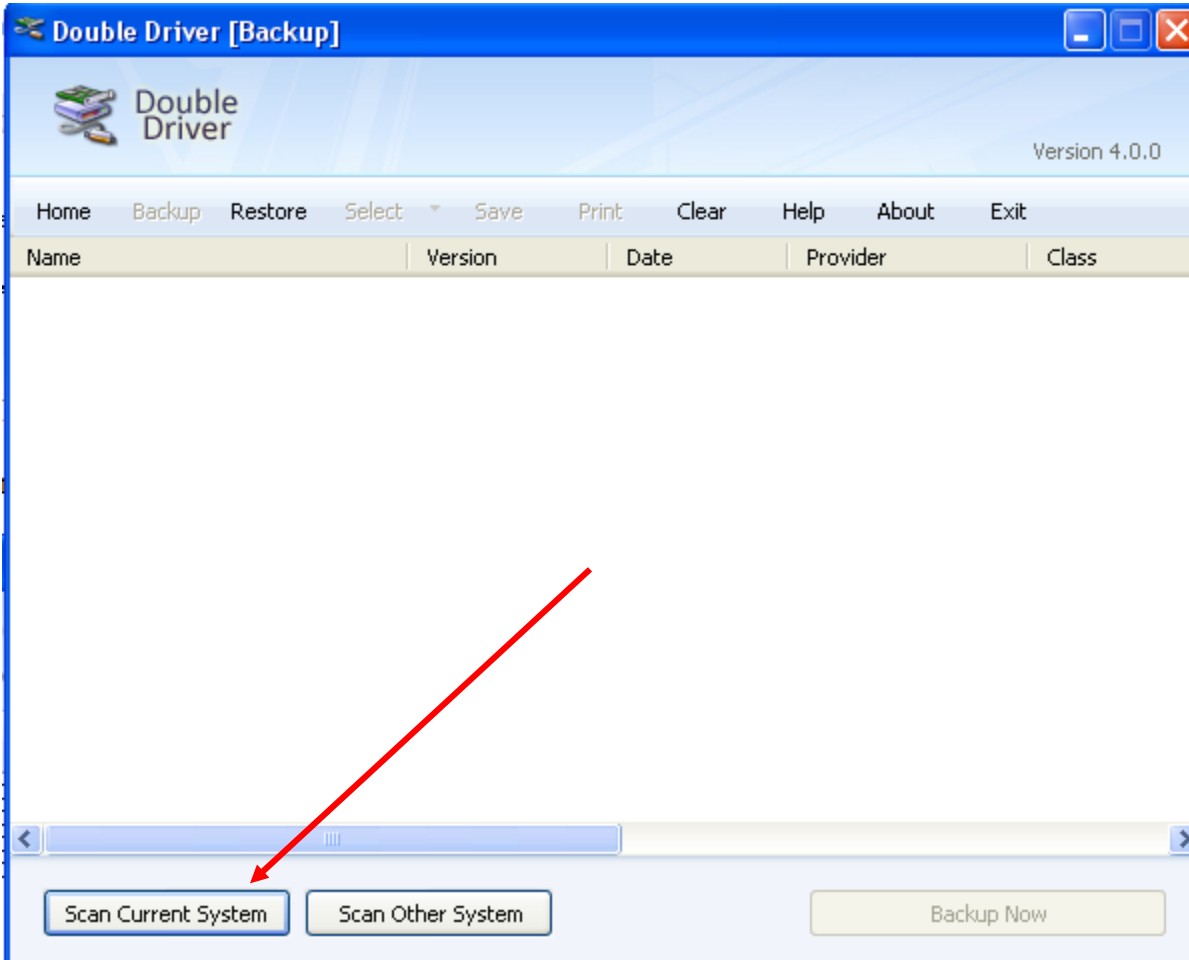

2. Double click on the dd.exe file to install the program.

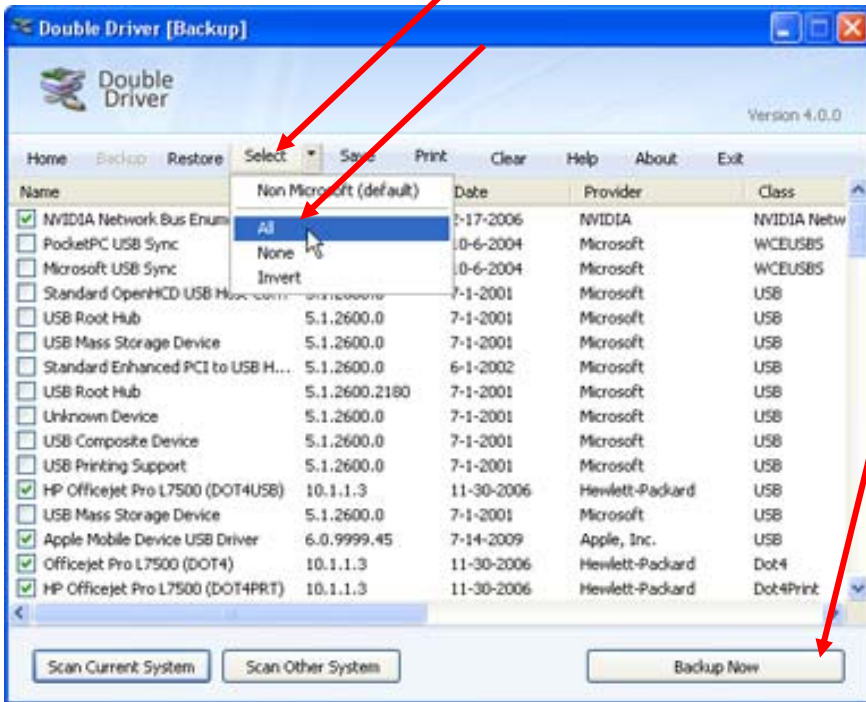
3. When you bring up the installed program, click on Backup.



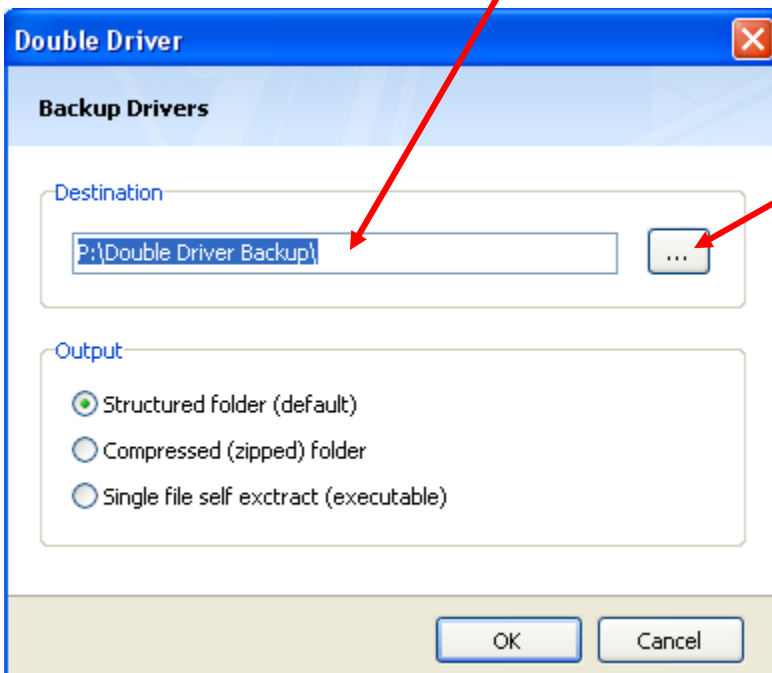
4. You will see this screen. Click on the **Scan Current System** button to have it begin to look throughout your computer system for drivers.



5. Click on the **Select** menu option and choose **All** from the drop down. You want it to get all of your drivers. After it checks all of your drivers, click on the **Backup Now** button.

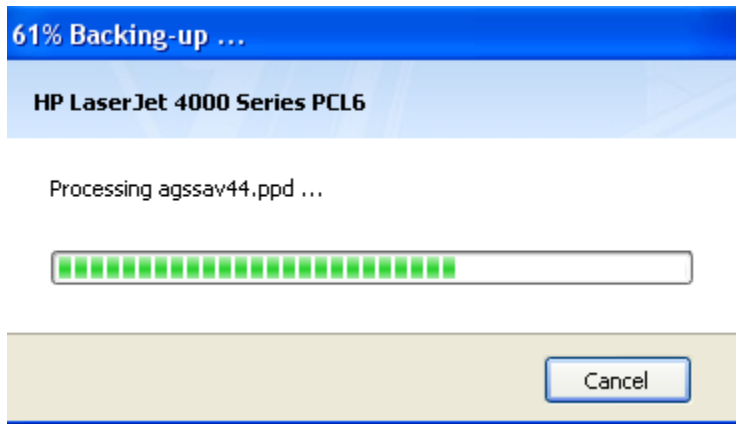


6. In the **Destination** field indicate where you want the driver copies placed. Use the **browse** button to find your location. A place other than your hard drive (that might be reformatted) would be your wisest choice. Think about an external hard drive, a CD or DVD, a thumb drive or a drive space in the internet cloud. You can probably leave the **Output** buttons as they appear.

7. The program will show you this progress screen until it is done.



Finally, you'll receive notice that it is done. Click on the **OK** button and then click on the **X**.
